Bolton Museum has been transformed into an ancient Egyptian gallery. Here, you can explore over 2,000 Egyptian artefacts and the stories behind them!

The artefacts are showcased interactively through audiovisuals, graphic designs and more. The new gallery also exhibits the iconic burial chamber of Thutmose III in full-size reproduction and the collection includes the oldest mummification sample in the world. Tours of the Museum can be arranged on request and take approximately 1.5-2 hours. Tours are free but donations are welcome.
